Students must take a minimum of 30 Business hours at UNCP, 9 hours of Writing Intensive courses and must complete the rest of UNC Pembroke's General Education Requirement to complete the 120 hours for the degree. Students must take at least one course from among those course identified as contributing to the internationalization mission of the School of Business.
- 3. A minimum of 25% of the semester hours needed for this degree must be completed in residence at UNC Pembroke.
